What will you do?

As a **Social Worker**, you will be responsible to support children/youth and families in the community, improving the situation of vulnerable children/youth and their families, and empowering youth to participate actively in their communities.

Your responsibilities will include the following:

- Provide counseling life skills to children/youth and their families in the youth center, on the streets, and in communities
- Support marginalized children/youth to solve problems
- Support children/youth and their families to access other services
- Train and support outreach workers to implement activities for youth in communities and in youth center
- Facilitate and communicate with institutions/authorities, NGO partners, and communities
- Monitoring, follow-up, and evaluation of cases
- Generate daily, monthly reports and activities plan for Program Manager
- Prepare requests for supporting the children/youth, families, and other concerned
- Other tasks based on needs as requested by Mith Samlanh management.

We would like you to have the following:

- Bachelor's degree in Psychology, Social Science, or related field
- Social work, counseling skills, ability to solve problems, youth activities

- At least 2 years of experience working with marginalized children, youth, and communities
- Computer and office technology: not necessary, but an advantage
- Able to speak and write English (an advantage but not essential)
- Very good communication, social work skills, flexible and dynamic.
