What will you do?

As a **Data Entry Volunteer** you will help M&E team to collect and enter data of various projects and surveys and ensure data accurate, safe and well organized.

Your responsibilities will include the following:

- To assist M&E team to collect and enter data from paper sheets into computer, databases and spreadsheets. The type of data varies from numerical to text based.
- To update and maintain the ChildSafe Movement online database
- To enter data from different surveys as needed.
- To ensure that all the data is kept safe and is well-organized
- To verify and ensure the data is accurate and of quality
- To undertake any other tasks as assigned by the supervisors

- Computer proficiency (MS.Word, Excel, Power Point, Internet, and Email), knowledge of SPSS and statistic is a plus.
