- Provide job guidance and career counseling to target beneficiaries for placement to job, business, hard skills, internship, apprenticeship, micro-training...etc.
- Strong, trustful relationships are established with all members of the community including beneficiaries, authorities, NGO partners and business partners.

- Promote Futures services to the community, authorities, and partners online and in person.
- Futures databases and employment directories are regularly maintained and updated.
- Network of referral structures for continuing education is built and expanded.
- Job and small business placement satisfaction is regularly monitored with clients and companies.
- Quality data is regularly collected, and internal reporting is conducted.
- Manage student passports (student's photos, study record, certificate, training, etc.)
- Coordination in the support (transportation, clothing, housing, hygiene, etc.) student to job placement.
